A walkable city, downtown employees can get needed errands done on their lunch hour, including banking at NBT, picking up prescriptions at Gloversville Pharmacy, ordering and purchasing floral arrangements at Peck's Flowers, and shopping at stores in the Downtown Corridor such as Rossbach Shoe Store, Kay's Beautique, Castiglione Gem Jewelers and Dunday's Clothiers. The Downtown Corridor is also home to several physicians and dentists, as well as

hair salons and barbershops, including optometrist Dr. David Rojeck, Harrison Family Dentist, Fulton County Barbershop, Capano's Hairitage Salon, and The Color Coven Looking for lunch? Visit the Mohawk Harvest Cooperative Market as it has a Grab & Go selection of meals. Historic New York Lunch is a sit down eatery and take out is available from Buck's Pizza, Jimmy's Deli, Eva's Soul Food and Peking Chinese Restaurant. Venture to Cravings Cafe & Bakery for a sweet treat and have dinner at the Brass Monkey.

**Aldi's**, 252 N. Comrie Ave.: 5 min. drive/2.5 miles away

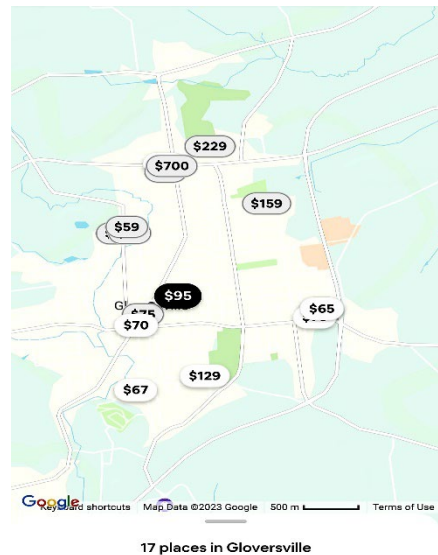
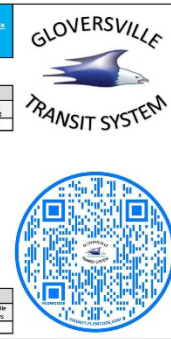

If other errands take employees and staff away from the city core, major chain stores and health care facilities are a short car ride away. Employees can utilize public parking lots, some that are located off Fremont Street (behind the Glove Theatre and NBT drive-thru windows), on the corner of Church and Bleecker Streets, and next to

the Farmers Market Pavilion at 9 Elm Street. All these lots are a block away from Main Street.

If transportation is needed, the city has a transit system that provides services to Gloversville, Amsterdam, Johnstown, the Industrial Parks, and Fulton-Montgomery Community College. Downtown bus stops with waiting booths include the four corners on Main Street and City Hall at Frontage Road. Glove City Taxi is a locally veteran owned business providing local and long distance taxi and airport shuttle services.
